

SPRING 2026, KECNY Korean Language Course Syllabus

1. Class: Korean (Intermediate)

This is a pre-intermediate course and will use **I Love Korean Book 3**, which covers nine units. This course introduces the different levels of speech, noun modifiers, future tense, present continuous tense, present perfect tense, negation, complex sentence formation, irregular verbs, and adjectives. Instruction is provided in four language modalities: speaking, listening, reading, and writing. By the end of the semester, students can demonstrate their knowledge of (topics/skills) through authentic performance tasks listed at the end of each unit.

Course Objectives

1. Produce and comprehend coordinate, complex, and compound Korean sentence structures in the present, past, and future tenses in informal polite style and honorific speech.
2. Read, write, and speak simple affirmative, negative, declarative, imperative, and interrogative sentences in informal polite form and honorific speech.
3. Get familiar with the irregular verbs and adjectives.
4. Be acquainted with sociolinguistic aspects of the language.
