- Course Title: **[In-Person] Korean 4**
- [ACTFL® Proficiency Level](#): Intermediate Mid - High
- Course Description: This course helps students develop Korean communication skills for adult learners by acquiring abilities to compose and use language that applies to everyday topics and functions.
- Learning Outcomes: By the end of the course, students will be able to understand and use topic-specific vocabulary related to daily life, consumer activities, the workplace, accidents, and visiting someone who is ill. They will also be able to report what they have heard or seen using indirect speech, confirm information, discuss hypothetical situations, and describe the condition of objects or people using passive constructions. In addition, students will develop a range of natural expressions that will help them transition smoothly to an advanced level.
