### 1. Course Information

- Course Title: **[In-Person] Korean 1A - 6PM**
- [ACTFL® Proficiency Level](#): Novice Low
- Course Description: This course introduces beginning learners to the fundamentals of the Korean language through communicative and interactive learning. Students will learn Hangeul (the Korean writing system), essential vocabulary, and basic grammatical structures needed for everyday communication. Emphasis is placed on developing listening and speaking skills through guided conversations, pair activities, and practical communication tasks. By the end of the course, students will be able to introduce themselves, exchange basic personal information, describe people and objects, express possession, and communicate in everyday situations such as greeting others and ordering food.
- Learning Outcomes: By the end of the course, students will be able to:
  1. Read and write Hangeul, including basic vowels, consonants, and final consonants (받침).
  2. Introduce themselves and exchange basic personal information using beginner-level Korean expressions.
  3. Ask and answer simple questions in everyday communicative situations.
  4. Describe people and everyday objects and express possession using essential vocabulary and basic grammatical structures.
  5. Participate in simple conversations related to greetings, classroom communication, and ordering food and drinks.
