

SPRING 2026, KECNY Korean Language Course Syllabus

1. Class: Korean 1A (Elementary)

This is the second half of the course in **I Love Korean Book 1**, which covers six units. This course introduces the Korean alphabet, **한글** (Hangeul), and instruction is provided in four modalities of language: speaking, listening, reading and writing. By the end of the semester, students can demonstrate their knowledge of (topics/skills) through authentic performance tasks listed at the end of each unit.

Course Objectives

1. Produce and comprehend coordinate, complex, and compound Korean sentence structures in present tense.
2. Read, write, and speak simple affirmative, negative, declarative, imperative, and interrogative sentences in plain style.
3. Get familiar with the basic verbs in -으}요/어요
4. Be acquainted with sociolinguistic aspects of the language.
